The High School

Oak Grove High School is part of Oak Grove School, an independent, pre-kindergarten through 12th grade school founded in 1975 by educator and philosopher J. Krishnamurti. The high school offers a four-year, coeducational, college-preparatory day and boarding program. The school is located in the Ojai Valley on 150 acres of oak-covered hills.

Accreditation

Accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges. Oak Grove is a member of CAIS, NAIS, NACAC, WACAC and TABS.

Admission

Admission is selective. High school capacity is 60 students, which includes up to 18 international and domestic boarding students

Faculty

The high school is comprised of 18 full- and part-time faculty.

Graduation Requirements

Minimum graduation requirements exceed the entrance requirements for the University of California and include the following:

Curriculum

Students are encouraged toward intellectual depth, aesthetic and environmental sensibility, social responsibility, physical vitality and an open-minded spirit of inquiry. Emphasis is placed on the academic subjects of English, math, laboratory science, foreign language, social science and fine arts, as well as ecology, community service, public speaking and elective subjects tied to our camping and travel program. English as a second language (ESL) tutoring is available.
